## **FY 2010 Interoperable Emergency Communications Grant Program (IECGP)**

- Most of the OEP offices who purchased CUROpro used this grant to pay for the software. There is a footnote in the guidelines on page 16 that states the following: "Note that the procurement of software packages that support emergency communications asset management activities is an allowable cost in FY 2010 IECGP."

## **FY 2010 Regional Catastrophic Preparedness Grant Program (RCPGP)**

## **FY2007 Public Safety Interoperable Communications (PSIC) Grant Program**

- To assist public safety agencies in the acquisition of, deployment of, or training for the use of interoperable communications systems that can utilize or enable interoperability with communications systems that can utilize reallocated public safety spectrum for radio communications.

## **FY2010 Buffer Zone Protection Program (BZPP)**

- BZPP provides funding to increase the preparedness capabilities of jurisdictions responsible for the safety and security of communities surrounding high-priority pre-designated Tier 1 and Tier 2 critical infrastructure and key resource (CIKR) assets.

## **FY2010 Citizen Corps Program (CCP)**

- The Citizen Corps mission is to bring community and government leaders together to coordinate community involvement in emergency preparedness, planning, mitigation, response and recovery.

## **FY2010 Emergency Management Performance Grants (EMPG)**

- The purpose of the FY 2010 EMPG is to assist state and local governments in enhancing and sustaining all-hazards emergency management capabilities.

## **FY2010 Emergency Operations Center (EOC) Grant Program**

- The Emergency Operations Center (EOC) Grant Program is intended to improve emergency management and preparedness capabilities by supporting flexible, sustainable, secure, and interoperable Emergency Operations Centers (EOCs) with a focus on addressing identified deficiencies and needs.

## **FY2010 Law Enforcement Terrorism Prevention Activity (LETPA-SHSP)**

- LETPA focuses upon the prevention of terrorist attacks and provides law enforcement and public safety communities with funds to support intelligence gathering and information sharing. States are required to ensure that at least 25 percent of their SHSP award funds and at least 25 percent of their UASI award funds are dedicated towards law enforcement terrorism prevention-oriented planning, organization, training, exercise, and equipment activities.

## **FY2010 Law Enforcement Terrorism Prevention Activity (LETPA-UASI)**

- LETPA focuses upon the prevention of terrorist attacks and provides law enforcement and public safety communities with funds to support intelligence gathering and information sharing. States are required to ensure that at least 25 percent of their SHSP award funds and at least 25 percent of their UASI award funds are dedicated towards law enforcement terrorism prevention-oriented planning, organization, training, exercise, and equipment activities.

## **FY2010 Metropolitan Medical Response System (MMRS) Program**

- The MMRS program supports the integration of emergency management, health, and medical systems into a coordinated response to mass casualty incidents caused by any hazard.

## **FY2010 Operation Stonegarden Grant Program (OPSG)**

- The intent of OPSG is to enhance cooperation and coordination among local, state and federal law enforcement agencies in a joint mission to secure the United States borders along routes of ingress from international borders to include travel corridors in states bordering Mexico and Canada, as well as states and territories with international water borders.

## **FY2010 Port Security Grant Program (PSGP)**

- The purpose of the FY 2010 PSGP is to create a sustainable, risk-based effort to protect critical port infrastructure from terrorism, particularly attacks using explosives and non-conventional threats that could cause major disruption to commerce.

## **FY2010 State Homeland Security Program (SHSP)**

- This core assistance program provides funds to build capabilities at the state and local levels and to implement the goals and objectives included in state homeland security strategies and initiatives in their State Preparedness Report.

## **FY2010 Tribal Homeland Security Grant Program (THSGP)**

- The purpose of the FY 2010 THSGP is to provide funding directly to eligible tribes to help strengthen the nation against risks associated with potential terrorist attacks.

## **FY2010 Urban Areas Security Initiative (UASI) Program**

- UASI program funds address the unique planning, organization, equipment, training, and exercise needs of high-threat, high-density Urban Areas, and assist them in building an enhanced and sustainable capacity to prevent, protect against, respond to, and recover from acts of terrorism.
